**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Affiliated Managers Group, Inc., a Delaware corporation (the “Company”), has adjusted the conversion rate applicable to the 5.15% Convertible Trust Preferred Securities due 2037 (the “Trust Preferred Securities”) of AMG Capital Trust II. The conversion rate adjustment is being made in accordance with Sections 17.03(d) and 17.03(h) of the Indenture, dated as of October 17, 2007, between the Company and U.S. Bank National Association (successor in interest to Bank of America, N.A., successor by merger to LaSalle Bank National Association), as amended or supplemented (the “Indenture”), as a result of the quarterly cash dividends paid by the Company on shares of its common stock (the “Common Stock”), beginning in the first quarter of 2017 and the previously announced quarterly cash dividend with an ex-dividend date of August 8, 2018 to be paid on August 23, 2018.

Effective immediately, the conversion rate is adjusted from 0.2500 shares of Common Stock per \$50.00 Trust Preferred Security to 0.2525 shares of Common Stock per \$50.00 Trust Preferred Security.

As required by the Indenture, the Company is notifying holders in accordance with the procedures of the Depository Trust Company, posting this notice on its website, and concurrently issuing a press release describing the conversion rate adjustment.
